RULES REGARDING SCHOOL FEE, WITHDRAWALS, TRANSFER CERTIFICATE

FEE

- 1. Fee will be deposited on 1st to 20th of fee month.
- 2. School fee will not be accepted without fee book. Duplicate fee book will be issued on payment of Rs. 100/-
- 3. Late fee of Rs. 50/- will be charged if the fee is late by one month.
- 4. Name of the students may be struck off the rolls if fee is not paid for two quarters in continuation.

WITHDRAWALS

The following categories of students will be expelled from the school not necessarily notifying the parents about the reasons there of :

- 1. Students, whose fees are in arrears for more than two quarters.
- 2. Students, who fail twice in the same class.
- 3. Students, whose conduct in the opinion of the "School Disciplinary Committee" is detrimental to the interests of the school.

TRANSFER CERTIFICATE

A formal application on a prescribed Application Form must be submitted with 'No Dues Certificate' signed by the Fee Clerk, Librarian, Heads of Science, Computer and Physical Education faculties and the Principal. The fee for obtaining a T.C. is Rs. 100/- and for getting the same countersigned by the Education Department of the State Govt. is Rs. 200/-. T.C. will not be issued unless the student has cleared all the school dues.



CODE OF CONDUCT

Please note that noncompliance with the school rules shall lead to consequences which may also include dismissal from the school. We expects our students to adhere to the code for:-

- 1. Students should be very polite wherever they go. They should always remember that the school is judged by their behaviour and conduct. Use of abusive language/passing filthy or vulgar comments will invite stern action immediately.
- 2. All students should greet their teachers whenever they meet them. No student should use any foul language against any teacher, visitor or guest of the school.
- 3. Students will not deface or damage school property. Any damage to school property should be reported to the Head Mistress immediately and school invite imposition of fine/issuance of warning/suspension.
- 4. Bullying, aggression or violence in any form is gross misconduct for which the school will take strict disciplinary action if required.
- 5. Students are expected to have strict adherence to school timings. Students will not be permitted to enter the school after commencement of school time.
- 6. Students should be in the proper uniform as prescribed. Proper length of skirts and shorts must be adhered to. Black shoes must be as defined in the uniform.
- 7. Boys should have short groomed haircut. (Non-Sikh boys).
- 8. Girls with long hair should have it tied in 2 braid. Only black hairclips, cream hair-band and red ribbons must be worn.
- 9. All students should have clipped nails. Girls are not permitted to wear nail paint.
- 10. Students are not permitted to wear expensive or flashy jewellery, watches and other accessories.
- 11. Students are not permitted to carry mobile phones on the school premises. Students are not permitted to bring valuable electronic devices (ipods, cameras, tablets etc) without the prior permission of the Head Mistress.
- 12. Strict discipline must be maintained in the school transport. Misbehaviour on the bus/van can lead to withdrawal of transport facilities.
- 13. Students must have a minimum attendance of 75% during the academic year in order to take the school examinations.
- 14. Sports are to be played with the correct spirit of sportsmanship. Aggression, fighting on the field and using abusive language will invite strict disciplinary action from the authorities.
- 15. The ALMANAC is to be brought to the school by the student every day. A student will be asked to change ALMANAC on tearing off any of its pages or improper maintenance. It will invite a fine of 50/for issue of new (second) ALMANAC.

FOR CLASS 1ST AND ONWARDS


The Five Areas of Development is a holistic approach to learning that strives to break down the silos in education and ensure the development of a learner in all Five areas of Development - Cerebral, Emotional, Physical, Social and Spiritual. Through this process of development, we hope to inspire our learners and equip them with the skills and processes that will help them navigate new content and challenges that the future might present. Vinayak International School, has developed a holistic curriculum focusing on the 5 Areas of Development. Each area is given equal weighting and the interconnection between all areas is emphasized.



1. Cerebral Development (the academic area) emphasizes communication, comprehension, critical thinking and curiosity to enhance academic learning.




2. Physical Development focuses on health, fitness and sports. It also involves developing control over the body, particularly muscles and physical coordination.

ACADEMICS

FOR PRE-PRIMARY

Child development is a process every child goes through. This process involves learning and mastering skills like sitting, walking, talking, skipping, and tying shoes. Children learn these skills, called Developmental Milestones, during predictable time periods. Children develop skills in five main areas of development:



1. Cognitive Development:-

This is the child's ability to learn and solve problems. For example, this includes a three-years-old child is learning alphabet or a five-year-old child learning how to do simple math problems.



2. Social and Emotional Development:-

This is the child's ability to interact with others, including helping themselves and self-control. Examples of this type of development would include, a three-year-old child walks in a line or a five-year-old child wait for his/her turns in games at school.



3. Speech and Language Development:-

This is the child's ability to both understand and use language. For example, this includes a two-year-old child naming parts of her body, or a five-year-old child learning to say "feet" instead of "foots".



4. Fine Motor Skill Development:-

This is the child's ability to use small muscles, specifically their hands and fingers, to pick up small objects, hold a spoon, turn pages in a book, or use a crayon to draw.



5. Gross Motor Skill Development:-

This is the child's ability to use large muscles. For example a two-years-old child learns how to build a tower or a five-year-old learns to skip.
